Deposit & Payment: A deposit of \$250 per person is required to secure a reservation. Final payment will be due by March 23, 2010.

Cancellation & Refund Policy: A full refund of all payments received will be given with written cancellation received by March 23, 2010. Cancellations received between March 24, 2010 and April 14, 2010, will be charged \$250 per person. Cancellations received between April 15 and May 12, 2010 will be charged 50% per person. Cancellation received between May 13 and May 25, 2010 will be charged 75% per person. Cancellation received after May 26, 2010, will receive no refund.
